John K. Small (1901) A Kentucky Cornel. Torreyia 1: 54.

Below is a statement from the John K. Small letter: "Several months since, Miss Sadie F. Price sent me flowering specimens of a Cornus, which she had found growing on river banks near Bowling Green. Later, at my request, she furnished me with fruiting specimens from the same locality. This material is, apparently, not referable to any species thus far described, and may hereafter be known as *Cornus priceae small.*"
